## REBECKA HERZ




Rebecka Herz nee Ter berg was born in Ritterhude, Germany in 1884. Prior to WWII she lived in Aumund, Germany. During the war she was in Minsk, Ghetto.

Rebecka was murdered in the Shoah.

This information is based on a List of murdered Jews from Germany found in List of Jewish victims from the Memorial book "Victims of the Persecution of Jews under the National Socialist Tyranny in Germany 1933 - 1945" prepared by the German Federal Archives.



During the Shoah, Jews were murdered in a variety of ways, among them gassing, shooting, burning, drowning or burial alive, exhaustion through forced labor, starvation, epidemic diseases, deprivation of medical care and minimal hygienic conditions, and more. Some Jews took their own lives in order to escape arrest and further persecution, or to end their hopeless, relentless suffering.
